

Mary Elizabeth Davidson Kidd Morgan



Elizabeth Kidd Morgan, 91, of Salmon and formerly of Ashton, died Friday, Nov. 9, 2012, at the Ashton Living Center of natural causes. She was born June 15, 1921, in Yates Center, Kan., to Cyrus Calvin and Mary Orebaugh Booth Davidson. She attended school at the Uinta grade school near Provo, Utah, and at Alexandra, Idaho, near Soda Springs. In the sixth grade, her family moved to Ashton and she attended school there until graduating from Ashton High School. After high school, she attended a semester at Brown University. She married Fern Kidd on Dec. 15, 1939, in Farnum, Idaho. Nine children were born to this marriage. They raised their family in Pocatello and Ashton. Fern died March 21, 1984. She married Stanley Morgan in June 1990. They made their home in Salmon and shared many good times together. Stanley died Jan. 16, 2007. She attended the Methodist Church in Ashton, then converted to The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints about the

time her son, Terry, was born. In the late 1940s, she returned to college to train as a nurse. She was devoted to her profession. She worked at the Ashton Hospital, St. Anthony Hospital in Pocatello and at the Idaho Youth Training Center in St. Anthony. She was very involved with her family. While her boys were young, she was active in the city baseball league in Pocatello. She loved gardening and most outdoor work and activities, including picking potatoes. She also loved kids and drove school buses for many years. She was a caregiver to many and a friend to all. She is survived by her children, Dianne (Jon) May, of Rockland, Colleen Lancaster, of Boise, Terry (Gloria) Kidd, of West Valley, Utah, Lynn (Judy) Kidd, of Cove, Ore., Jack Kidd, of Salmon, John (Barbara) Kidd, of Garden Valley, Kevin (Kathy) Kidd, of Redding, Calif., and Wendy Kidd, Howell of Salmon; siblings, John (Vicki) Davidson, of Idaho Falls, Edward (Ellen) Davidson, of West Valley, Utah, and Bill (Jean) Davidson, and Paula (Gene) Christiansen, both of Pocatello; 27 grandchildren; 46 great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandchild.
